MIRTA ALVAREZ

Mirta Alvarez, born in Chascomús, Buenos Aires, is a distinguished concert guitarist, arranger, composer, and singer. She graduated as a Superior Guitar Teacher from the Conservatory of Chascomús and further specialized in Tango and Folklore Guitar at the Escuela de Música Popular de Avellaneda under maestros Aníbal Arias and Kelo Palacios.

As a renowned artist in Argentine popular music, Mirta performs her own arrangements and original works, blending instrumental and vocal pieces with poetry. She regularly graces prestigious festivals and venues worldwide, including the Festival de Guitarras del Mundo (Argentina), Semana de la Guitarra de Petrer (Spain), and Tampere Festival Guitar (Finland).

In addition to her performance career, Mirta teaches Tango Guitar, Tango Appreciation, and Tango History at the Escuela de Música Popular de Avellaneda. She has published a book of tango arrangements and collaborates with Guitare Classique Magazine. Her discography includes albums such as "Mirta Alvarez, guitarra" (2006), "Tango, seis caminos de amor" (2011), and "Música Argentina" (2019).
